

Effective Teaching at Navitas

Learning and Teaching Services

Duration: 5 weeks

Mode(s) of delivery: Online

Live sessions: Throughout the course there will be weekly live sessions which will also be recorded.

Workload: 15 hours over a 5-week period

Introduction

This 5-week course will provide new teachers with a structured understanding of the learning and teaching approaches and ideas at the core of the student experience within Navitas. You will have the opportunity to explore and create a personal learning and teaching philosophy which supports your students in their learning journey. Importantly, the course also explores and encourages you to apply these principles to your own teaching context. On successful completion of the course you will receive a **Certificate of Completion**.

Learning outcomes

On successful completion of this course you will be able to:

- Describe how your teaching practice is situated within the higher education landscape, particularly in context to Navitas.
- Explain the importance of aligning teaching, learning and assessment activities for coherence using constructive alignment as a principle.
- Appraise a variety of learner-centred teaching strategies in the context of higher education.
- Appraise a variety of feedback and assessment strategies in the context of higher education.
- Evaluate your own teaching practice against established higher education standards.

Course delivery

You will use a range of learning technologies during the course which will be facilitated within Navitas Core Moodle as well as via Zoom (for live sessions). You are required to have access to the Internet. A webcam and headset microphone are also recommended for live sessions.

Target participants

This course is aimed at teaching staff who are new to teaching (under 2 years) and/or new to teaching at Navitas, as well as staff that would like to reconnect with the Navitas pedagogy of learning and teaching. The course is a professional development activity available to all teaching staff within Navitas.

Weekly study pattern

You are expected to commit a minimum of 15 hours over the 5-week period. On a weekly basis, you will attend or watch a 1-hour live session and engage in 1 hour of reading and 1 hour of individual or group activities; these will include discussions, submitting material for feedback and providing feedback to other participants.

It is expected that you will be actively engaging in activities during each week of the course.
